Revitalize Yourself

"And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers...So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved" (Acts 2:42, 46, 47).

During the earliest stages in the development of the church, the apostles were as yet the only teachers, and in this work they were executing the second part of their commission (Mat. 28:20). This would require them to teach those whom they immersed all things that Jesus had commanded. Of equal importance to this duty was the responsibility of the disciples to learn from them and to faithfully abide by their instruction. From all indications, this duty was met through their frequent assemblies, and their common participation in religious activities.
