KEN'S PEN
The Whirl of a Squirrel

"There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death" (Pro. 16:25). Not very long ago, I took note of a squirrel as it thoughtlessly scurried across some power lines in an attempt to reach a potentially valuable piece of real estate. For a split second, I found myself shocked by what I saw. Was this furry little animal not aware of the high voltage traveling beneath its feet, not to mention the deadly drop that one missed step would deliver? I don't think so. It probably would not be too much to assume that the little fellow had attempted this feat many times before, and was oblivious to the looming threat.

Why doesn't the possibility of physical harm create a sense of foreboding danger in this little creature? Can't he find an easier way to make a living? I suppose he either has a limited ability to rationally weigh the inherent dangers of such actions, or he simply does not care about the danger: He might easily be characterized by the "It could never happen to me" mentality.

Unfortunately, squirrels aren't the only ones taking such chances. Our society is filled with the victims of "power line" thinking. Alcoholism, drug addiction, teenage pregnancy, and a host of other tragedies have become so commonplace that many no longer perceive them as a threat to our way of life. Is it possible that the majority has become so overwhelmed with its inability to curb the indulgences of its youth that it is now interested in accepting its failure through tolerance, rather than dealing with the realities of sin and its consequences?

It is truly sad that so many have chosen to thoughtlessly go out on the power lines of life, rather than to consider the safety found in firmly holding on to the tree! "What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life" (Rom. 6:21f).
