KEN'S PEN
Doing Time

If it is convenient for you, stop for just a moment and think about the past five years of your life.... Does it seem possible that so many changes could have taken place in such a short time? It is probable that you have had one or more of the following changes: a new home; a new occupation; additional pounds or inches; (a preacher who is meddling); a birth into your family; a death near to you; a marriage; a divorce; etc., etc., etc.... No matter what changes have occurred, it is almost certain that you would not have believed that they were possible five years ago. If that seems remarkable, consider the past week's events? Did it hold within it the potential to redirect the next five years? Will there even be five more years? The point is this: we are woefully unequipped to accurately dictate the events of our future.

Biblical wisdom constantly reminds us of these uncertainties, especially as they are seen in the context of man's constant desire to write his own unforeseeable future: "Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth" (Pro. 27:1). Can we easily disregard this good caution against presuming too much about the time to come? We are certainly not being encouraged to avoid reasonable preparations for tomorrow, but we are receiving a warning against the all too common practice of presuming upon tomorrow. We cannot, due to our inherent lack of prophetic foresight, be so haughty as to promise ourselves the continuance of life and comforts until tomorrow.

Our preparations must be founded in a submissive reverence to the will of our gracious heavenly Father. Jesus taught us not to worry about tomorrow (Mat. 6:34) since we have no personal control over its outcome. What uncertain event is awaiting us as we vaunt our hopeful thoughts upon the future? Thankfully, God has wisely kept us in the dark concerning future events, and reserved to Himself the certain knowledge of them. Let us submit ourselves totally to the all-knowing God as He trains us up in a dependence upon Him, with a continued readiness for every event.
