By the grace of God, we all are fine. I thank you very much for the regular support to function the activities for the betterment of the Lord's work here in Ryali area, and to help with the supports of children of the Home, all of our Ryali area Preachers working hard to save the souls and preach the Saving Gospel to many in each and every day to reach the people and touch hearts with Gospel. Since 1993 more than 106 congregations have been established. From January to July 2009, six new congregations have been established with 125 baptisms at those locations. A total of 401 baptisms have taken place from January 2009 to June 30, 2009. Last year (from January 2008 to December 2008) there were 881 baptisms.



The preachers training School and Song of Joy School is functioning well for the Glory of the Lord and all the children and Trainee preachers feel that this is their best time to learn the Word of God and N.T.Truth and to preach it and save the Souls. The students are taking each chance and opportunity to learn more and more.
