KEN'S PEN

Coping with Anxiety

All of us, at one point or another, are faced with bouts of anxiety and despair. How we deal with these moments of trial tell a great deal about where we place our confidence for resolution. The psalmist, as he reflected upon the various difficulties that arise, said to "Cast your burden on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved" (Psa. 55:22). The legitimate concerns that we possess have in them the tendency toward extreme overreaction (and in some cases, sin) if they are dealt with from a self-centered attitude: An attitude with little or no regard for God.

The act of avoiding anxiety and worldly care is an admonition of the Lord that is pronounced ceaselessly, and reiterated by the apostles in an attempt to create in us a reliance upon God's uplifting hand in the face of life's disappointments. Needless stresses, which tend to preoccupy our thinking, are to be avoided lest we nurture them to transgression. The very essence of such anxieties is seen in the misconception that we must handle our lot in life totally on our own, even to the exclusion of God. Perhaps this denial of God's interest in our struggles stems from the idea that God will somehow apathetically overlook our infirmities, and force us to face life in a lonely state of dejection. He who cannot place his affairs confidently into the Lord's trust, but insists on finding his own way, is very likely to be tempted to use the wrong methods in helping himself.

Anxiety causes us to doubt God's loving-kindness, and creates an atmosphere where our love for Him is subject to growing cold. This increasing lack of confidence sets us on a path that ultimately wanders far from Him into deeper and deeper pits of despair, until all seems hopelessly lost. However, when we learn to cast each burden upon Him, His strength will carry us through the worst of trials.

Ways to Keep From Getting the Flu



- Get a seasonal flu shot
- Wash your hands often
- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Cover-cough or sneeze with tissue, not hands
- Stay several feet away from people with flu
- Clean household surfaces
- Sterilize house surfaces
 - a. Household bleach: dilute 3/4 c. of bleach into one gallon of water
 - b. Rubbing alcohol: 70% isopropyl alcohol or 60% ethyl alcohol. Do not dilute.
- Disinfect material and areas contaminated by virus.
- Follow label warnings and wear gloves.
