KEN'S PEN

Consolation in Christ

"For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. Now if we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer. Or if we are comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. And our hope for you is steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also you will partake of the consolation" (2 Cor. 1:5-7).

The "consolation" of this text refers to that which is "called in." The word, whose meaning begins with a relatively general denotation, flowers into other meanings that span the horizon of interpersonal expression: "to ask," "to exhort," "to request," and, although examples are rare, "to speak consoling words." To receive consolation, as in the "consolation in Christ," is to receive instructive admonitions whose end is the conservation of our souls.

This openness to instruction has primarily to do with imparting intellectual insight and knowledge. It is an education of the whole man that begins during the early stage of Christian development and extends throughout the entire maturation process.

Along with instruction comes a secondary component of exhortation that exerts influence upon the will and decisions with the object of offering guidance into God's biblically revealed code of behavior. Since exhortation is predicated upon some previous knowledge, it consists of reminding a person of prior commitments with the intention that he should carry them out.

Underlying this developmental role of consolation is the sense of a wise counsel or admonition that rouses and braces the moral nature and encourages and strengthens it to do and to endure. When, therefore, Christ says "Blessed are those who mourn, For they shall be comforted" (Mat. 5:4), He speaks in recognition of the fact that all sorrow is the outcome of sin, and that true comfort is given, not only in pardon for the past, but in strength to fight and resist and overcome sin. The protective environment of the word, in short, is not the claustrophobic atmosphere of a hospital room, but the healing breath of the open world, of moral struggle and victory; a spacious atmosphere for him who climbs and toils and fights.
