2010 Care Groups Ministry

The Bible outlines several objectives for a caring church:

- Unity (1 Cor. 12:25-26);
- Concern for one another (Gal. 6:1-2);
- Encouragement (1 Ths. 5:11; Heb. 10:24-25);
- Prayer for one another (Jam. 5:16);
- Hospitality (Rom. 12:13);
- Love (Mat. 22:37-39);

In order to more consistently attain to these biblical objectives, our elders are encouraging participation in a ministry that creates an environment through which people can gather together in a more personal atmosphere, where love is openly expressed, to build a bond of love for each other and for God, to encourage and pray for one another, to support each other during times of struggle and change, to study the Word of God, and to evangelize friends and neighbors in a non-threatening way. This ministry is referred to as our "Care Groups Ministry" (CGM).

This ministry involves one Sunday evening per month. On a "CGM Sunday," our Sunday morning worship and Bible school will proceed as usual. Then, beginning at 6:00 PM, we will meet for a shortened evening worship period at the building. Most CGM groups will then meet at homes as determined by the individual team leaders.

In the intervening period between now and February 21, 2010, you are encouraged to volunteer for various levels of active participation. Team assignments are being made on a first-come-first-served basis. One of the goals of the CGM Teams is to include ALL members who want to be a part of the activity, regardless of AGE. If you have any questions regarding the program, please direct your enquiries to the elders or me.

On behalf of the elders, I want to thank you ahead of time for your commitment to making the Cullman church of Christ a more caring, service oriented church!
