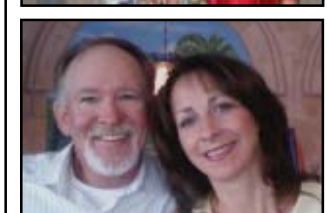

# Family Matters

Or do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, tolerance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness leads you toward repentance?  
Romans 2:4



**KEN'S PEN**  
**Holding the Faith Without Partiality**

It is not uncommon, when placed into uncertain situations, to gravitate toward items that temporarily give us security and comfort. Babies, when forced to expand their horizons, typically cry for their old familiar "blankie" or "binkie" in order to soothe their anxieties with a reminder of the securities of home and mother. As we grow, our insecurities may continue along, but the "blankie" or "binkie" will no longer suffice! It is in such situations that we may try to create a familiar environment by surrounding ourselves with people of similar interests and opinions. This artificial environment would be the answer to most or our social concerns were it not for the fact that it contributes to the stifling of fellowship and outreach. If our social horizon remains relatively low, the possibility of developing the mindset of exclusionism and bigotry will become a serious threat. The Corinthian church (1 Cor. 1:10-17) serves as an example of how far social separation can take us from God's plan for His church.

As having become different from the world (Rom. 12:2), God's people do not make distinctions between who is, and who is not, worthy of our attention within the fellowship of the church. The same blood that cleansed our unworthy souls (Rom. 5:6-11) also makes possible the cleansing of the African-American, Hispanic, and Asian; garbage truck driver, ditch digger and corporate C.E.O.; home owner, apartment dweller, and street person; blind, deaf, and impaired of all kinds. Will we withhold God's soothing balm from the weak and oppressed? Will we become guilty of unholy antagonism through non-verbal abuses of those whom we deem unworthy of our attention?

"My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality... Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him? But you have dishonored the poor man. Do not the rich oppress you and drag you into the courts? Do they not blaspheme that noble name by which you are called? If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you do well; but if you show partiality, you commit sin, and are convicted by the law as transgressors" (Jam. 2:1-9).

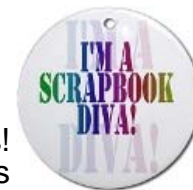
## Pictorial Directory Update
