We Are "The Champions"

Most of us have never experienced the exhilaration of having won a championship or some other comparable victory. We vicariously play for our favorite teams by wearing their licensed merchandise (caps, shirts, vanity plates, et. al.), but have no legitimate right to be called "The Champions" when they finally win the prize. We sit on the edge of our seats...we scream out unintelligible cheers...we dress like silly clowns from the circus. All of this is done in an attempt to share in someone else's temporary exhibition of greatness.

Are we doomed to a lifetime of championships by proxy; an endless stream of glorious illusions? No! Take comfort in knowing that there is an infinitely more satisfying goal that rises above the useless grandeur of annualized contests: "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith" (1 John 5:4).

The victory that we seek is one that is achieved through self-denial and predictable suffering. It is not the lonely road of sadness and regret, but rather of unexplainable peace and joy: "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). It is a victory that looks beyond the current state of being to a glory that triumphs in seeming defeat.

If you are among God's champions, you will never experience the dismay at having gained the victory, only to have it taken away in a subsequent season. God's champions do not wear soon-forgotten, perishable crowns. Quite to the contrary, God's champions wear crowns that will endure forever (1 Cor. 9:25). Truly, "in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us" (Rom. 8:37).
