**Inspiration of the Scriptures**

Do you trust in the inspiration of the Holy Scriptures? If these writings are not inspired of God, then they are the fallible production of man, thereby possessing no authority or redeeming religious value. However, if these writings are the inspired Word of God, then our obligation to obey them should be without exception.

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ, wrote, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:16f). The original Greek text is undeniable in its emphasis: "all scripture (is) God-breathed." The stress of this statement is in the fact that there is something said to be "God-breathed." What is it? All Scripture! The term "scripture" refers to that which is written. Since the words of the text are the primary point of emphasis, our conclusion must be that the very words of the Bible are "God-breathed," an appeal to 2 Timothy 3:16 that reveals the revelation of God to be verbally inspired.

In addition to passages that reinforce their own inspiration, the biblical writers considered one another's writings to be inspired of God. In 1 Timothy 5:18, Paul writes: "For the Scripture says, 'You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain,' and, 'The laborer is worthy of his wages.'" In this passage, the apostle has combined Deuteronomy 25:4 and Luke 10:7, and classified them both as "Scripture." Similarly, Peter refers to Paul's epistles as "Scripture" in 2 Peter 3:15f.

The Scriptures are the undeniably inspired Word of God. Let us therefore acknowledge the Holy Scriptures as "living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb. 4:12), and recognize them as the only authoritative source for guidance in our lives.
