Our missionaries in Catacamus, Honduras are Les and Jeannell Johnson. They work as the Village Coordinators for Por Los Ninos, a children's home that takes in destitute children, usually under the age of six, and provides a Christian environment where the children will

become spiritually, psychologically, and physically healthy. The Village consists of four homes, each with Christian Honduran houseparents and ten children (not including the houseparents' children). There is a Village School that consists of grades one through six. Les and Jeannell love the children of Por Los Ninos and oversee all of the day-to-day operations there. Once we step off the plane in Honduras we begin our second leg of the trip to the Por Los Niño's children's home in Catacamas, about a 4 hour ride in a cramped, hot van. While at Por Los Niño's we will be doing several things to help and interact with the children. In the mornings while the children of Por Los Ninos are in school, our project is scraping paint off an old building and repainting it. Once we finish that you never know what Les will put us to work doing. In the afternoons we have a VBS planned for all the children. The theme is "David the King". We will look at the different aspects of King David and how Jesus fulfills them in our lives. After that we play, play, play! The children love to play. Mostly we play "football" we call it soccer. Everyone is excited and is looking forward to an exciting and rewarding trip. **If you would like to hear about our trip once we return there will be a special bible class where everyone will share their experience Sunday, June 20th in the large auditorium.** Come see and hear the difference YOU made by supporting this mission.
