Life As It Ought To Be Lived

"1In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2He was in the beginning with God. 3All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4In Him was life, and the life was the light of men... 14And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:1-4, 14).

From mankind's earliest of beginnings, the work and majesty of the Son of God has ever been present. As man's relationship with God crumbled beneath the weight of sin, a suitable solution to his greatest need was already being prepared. Beyond the comprehension of human thought, God set a course of reconciliation that would span the course of time and alter the destiny of the faithful few.

Before the final implementation of Christ into this plan of reconciliation, Israel found itself struggling with its rightful place in relation to the will of God. It is not enough for us to merely read these accounts with passing interest; we must also internalize the message that saturates the pages of these Scriptures.
