KEN'S PEN

Burden Casting

"Cast your burden on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved" (Psa. 55:22). The careful concerns that we possess, even though expended upon legitimate problems, if carried to excess, have in them the potential for inadvertent sin. Our efforts may seem appropriate for the given circumstance only to reveal substantial faults with the passing of time.

The need to face and overcome the tendency toward anxiety and worldly care is an admonition of the Lord that is pronounced ceaselessly. Needless stresses, which tend to preoccupy our thinking, are to be avoided lest we nurture them to transgression. The faulty misconception that we must handle our lot in life totally on our own—even to the exclusion of God's promised assistance—is at the very heart of such troubling anxieties. If our attention is monopolized by thoughts of fear and defeat, it may be that we have begun to distance ourselves from the God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3).

Perhaps this denial of God's concern for our struggles stems from the idea that God will somehow apathetically overlook our infirmities, and force us to face life drowning in our own insecurities. It is uncertain as to how one might derive such a view given the heavy emphasis that Jesus makes of God's Fatherhood. He who cannot place his affairs confidently into the Lord's trust, but insists on finding his own way, is very likely to be tempted to use the wrong methods in helping himself.

Anxiety causes us to doubt God's loving-kindness, and thus creates an atmosphere where our love for Him is subject to growing cold. This increasing lack of confidence sets us on a path that ultimately wanders far from Him into deeper and deeper pits of despair, until all seems hopelessly lost. However, when we learn to cast each burden upon Him, and are "careful for nothing," we will draw even closer to Him, and our strength will carry us through the worst of trials.
