The Empty Glory of Man

Much of what God expects of us centers around our personal relationships. Because God has been good to us, we should likewise be good to others (Mat. 7:12; 22:34-40).

In a perfect world, we would be able to maintain tranquility with our fellow man, and promote the kind of selfless relationships that God expects. But, temptation is a strong force that positions itself against our striving after perfection in holiness (1 Pet. 5:8).

The young are tempted (Joseph).

The strong are tempted (Samson).

Men of nobility are tempted (Saul; David).

Common people are tempted (Gehazi; Achan).

Christ was tempted (Mat. 4:1-12; Heb. 4:15).

Often, personal aspirations cause us to endanger the servant mentality that is otherwise a major component of what makes us Christlike; that hard fought determination that places others before "self."

A truly humble person refuses to do anything for selfish ambition or vain conceit. This goes a long way toward the removal of disharmony (Rom. 12:9f; Phi. 2:14; Pro. 13:10; Jas. 3:14-18).

In this humble state, we are determined to encourage and help others when needed. When each member of the Christian community exercises this mutual concern, problems of disunity will quickly disappear (Cf. Rom. 12:15; Gal. 5:14 (Mat. 22:39)).

This presents a contrast between the empty glory of man who willfully grasps at what he does not have, and the glory of Christ who willingly emptied Himself of that which was always His (Phi. 2:1-8). In this, Jesus both taught and demonstrated to us what it actually means to have "lowliness of mind" (Mat. 20:26-28; John 13:1-17).
